INTRODUCTION

- How easy is it to live a good life?
- In our focus passage we Paul calling upon Titus to summon the people to a life that is characterized by respectability, redemption and irreproachability.

INVESTIGATION

- Verses 1-2 - *The people were to be Reminded of their Calling*
So as to show regard for: Powers (v 1a)
Principles (v 1b)
People (v 2)
- Verses 3-7 - *The people were to be Reminded of their Conversion*
So as to be mindful that they **were** - Living in a state of Riot (v 3)
So as to be mindful that now they **are** - Living in a state of Redemption (v 4 – 5a)
Living in a state of Regeneration (v 5b-6)
Living in a state of Reassurance (v 7)
- Verses 8-11- *The people were to be Reminded of their Community*
So as to be mindful that they should - Strive for the Ultimate (v.8)
Shun the Useless (v 9)
Separate from the Ugly (vv10&11)
